\$45 Principal membership includes registration of 3 horses, and one USDF group membership. \$17 of this goes to USDF for GMO dues. There is a discount on your USDF participating membership if applicable. Apply to USDF for this. **Remember. For your show scores to qualify for KDA year end awards you must be a member in good standing at the time of the show. Renew your membership early.**

Additional family members fall under the category of sustaining membership with dues of \$10 each. \$8 of this goes to USDF for GMO dues. No discount is available for USDF participating membership. See www.usdf.org for details of GMO benefits.

Year end award eligibility

See KDA web site for full year end award rules. (www.kentuckydressageassociation.org)

To be eligible for year-end awards, along with your membership, you must also register your horse(s) with the KDA, and you must complete (4) volunteer hours with any combination of the following options:

- Volunteer 4 hours at KDA Spring Show OR
 - 2 hours at KDA Spring Show and 2 hours at other KDA sponsored events
 - Recruit 4 new members (1 volunteer hr. per member) (anyone not a member last year is considered a new member)
 - Solicit \$250 of sponsorships for KDA Spring Show and not requesting a free stall earns 4 hrs
 - Write a published feature article for the newsletter (750 word minimum) earns 2 hrs
 - Actively participate on the KDA board or committee = 2 volunteer hours
 - Design & conduct a KDA seminar/workshop: 1 hour seminar = 1.5 volunteer hours; 2 hour seminar = 3 volunteer hours; 3 hour seminar = 4 volunteer hours.

KDA is a USDF Group Member Organization (GMO). All KDA members are automatically USDF group members.
